I found a quote from a power point I thought fit really well with this, 'To know what to do for a kid without a knowledge of that kid's variables is often little more than a hopeful shot in the dark.' (L11 S7, p. 116) Kids do need time for being kids, but my vision of classroom management involves procedures and routines because there is only so much that can get done in a day and when the students are aware of what their expected behavior is and when the teacher doesn't have to spend time reminding them of simple procedures, more learning can take place. The most important part of procedures and routines is consistency, because 'as an effective teacher, you rehearse the procedure again, and again.' (Wong, 49)






